Last Wednesday, I was in church listening to our Minister of Maturity and Education, Wade Liberator, giving the message. No good or bad deed changes that, so be encouraged, and be at peace. There is a song I used to listen to that asks "God, would you love me just as much if I were just your stupid kid?" The song talks about a lazy person that never does anything productive, but they find that God still loves them just as much, and that motivates them to get on with their life. So, rest in His love. His love is big, and it has plenty of room for you!
