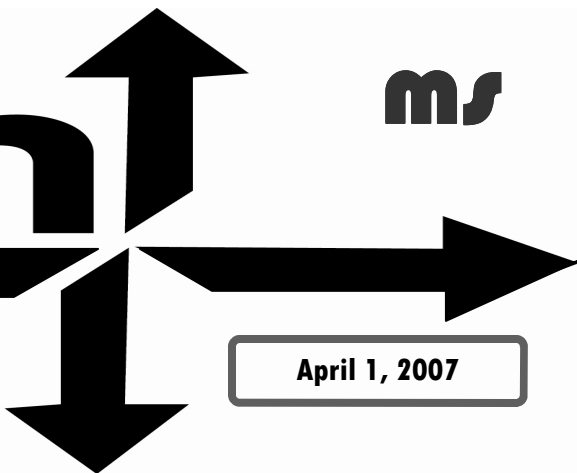

bled himself and supported God's will. Jonathan even saved David's life from Jonathan's dad, Saul who wanted to kill David. Like I said last week, true friendship doesn't come easy. Last week I met with someone I haven't known long, but he already displayed traits that make up true friendship. He asked all about me and asked how he could be praying for me.
