Eugene M. Bartlett wrote the words and music to the hymn, “Victory in Jesus.” He wrote it in 1939.

Mr. Bartlett was a gospel singer, composer and singing school teacher in Arkansas. He traveled around the country and held “singing conventions” which helped train many hundreds of future music teachers, singers, and songwriters. He published several song books and a magazine.

Mr. Bartlett wrote in this song about the victory in Jesus. He writes in the first verse that because he repented of his sins he was won the victory. What does it mean to repent? It means to feel sadness and regret because of our sin then we turn and do the right thing. Because we all have sinned, we all need God’s forgiveness in our lives in order to have victory in Jesus.
