“Jeg bor i Sandefjord, Norge.” This means, “I live in Sandefjord, Norway.”

William Dove and his younger brother, Daniel, live in Sandefjord, Norway. Their parents, Jennifer and Zack, are missionaries.

In the wintertime it is icy, cold, and dark most of the day in Norway. Will and Daniel like to go skiing and hang out with their friends. In the summertime it is very bright, and the boys play football (soccer) or ride bikes. They also play board games and watch TV. They like to go to the candy store, too!

William and Daniel like to go to school, where they have Norwegian classes, music, physical education, and art. A lot of the kids at school do not know about Jesus or believe in Him. They might have heard Jesus’ name, but no one has talked to them about Him. William and Daniel tell the kids about Jesus. They want their friends to know that the stories in the Bible are true and really happened. William and Daniel look for ways to tell their friends, “Jesus elsker deg,” which means “Jesus loves you.”

Most Norwegians today do not have a personal relationship with Jesus and many are not interested in believing in Him. The Dove family is sad that many beautiful church buildings in Norway are empty or have been turned into cafes or other businesses. The Doves want people in Norway to worship God again!

Zack and Jennifer believe it is important for all Christians, no matter where they live, to tell others about Jesus. Jennifer asks, “If you have this amazing thing that has happened to you, how can you just keep it to yourself?” She encourages Christians to know what they believe about Jesus and be ready to share it through acts of kindness and hospitality to others.

Pray that Zack, Jennifer, William, and Daniel Dove will find ways to open the empty churches in Norway so that many people will believe and love Jesus and will come to worship Him.






Missionaries Zack and Jennifer Dove live in Norway so they can tell people there about Jesus.




