Pretend to ride a donkey. Say, "Jesus is the king!"	<b>4</b> Read Matthew 21:1-7 How did the disciples obey Jesus? How can you obey Jesus today	<b>5</b> Read Matthew 21:1-9 What did the people shout? Listen to your favorite worship song. Wave branches, leaves, or Kleenex and praise Jesus.	<b>6</b> Read Matthew 21:1-10 What did the people ask? Who is Jesus to you? Do you now Jesus as your Savior and Lord?	<b>7</b> <b>The Triumphal Entry</b>
<b>8</b> Read Luke 22:7-8 Download the YouVersion Bible App for Kids. Watch "A Goodbye Meal."	<b>9</b> Read Luke 22:7-11 What did Jesus ask the disciples to do? Take a water bottle to neighbors. Invite them to church on Easter Sunday.	<b>10</b> Read Luke 22:7-13 What did the disciples prepare? Prepare a snack or meal for your family. Set the table. Talk about the meaning of Easter while eating.	<b>11</b> Read Luke 22:7-15 What did Jesus mean, "before I suffer?" Jesus knew he was going to die for us. He took the punishment for our sin - death.	<b>12</b> Read Luke 22: 19 Eat bread or crackers with your family. Talk about Jesus and how he died for us.	<b>13</b> Read Luke 22:20 Drink juice with your family. Talk about Jesus dying on the cross. Jesus bled when he died. Thank Jesus for dying and saving us.	<b>14</b> <b>The Lord's Supper</b>
<b>15</b> Read Matthew 26:36 What was Jesus going to do? Find a place outside. Pray and talk to God. Write him a letter. Sing a song to him. Build something special for God.	<b>16</b> Read Matthew 26:36-39 How did Jesus feel? What did Jesus do when he was sad? Talk to God about what makes you feel sad.	<b>17</b> Read Matthew 26:36-41 What were the disciples doing while Jesus was sleeping? Do you have friends that love God? Pray for your friends today.	<b>18</b> Read Matthew 26:36-46 Download the YouVersion Bible App for Kids. Watch "In The Garden."	<b>19</b> Read Matthew 26:47-50 How does it feel when someone betrays you? Who betrayed Jesus? Promise Jesus that you will never betray him but always follow him.	<b>20</b> Read Matthew 26:51-56 How did Jesus respond when his disciple tried to protect him? Confess times when you have hurt others. Pray for anyone who has hurt you.	<b>21</b> <b>The Garden of Gethsemane</b>
<b>22</b> Read Matthew 26:69-75 How did Peter deny Jesus? Have you ever been ashamed of Jesus? Tell Jesus why you love him.	<b>23</b> Read Matthew 27:1-2 List the people who were against Jesus. Do you know people who do not know or believe in Jesus? Pray for them today. Invite them to church on Easter.	<b>24</b> Read Matthew 27:1-5 Why do you think did Judas changed his mind? Have you ever doubted or sinned against Jesus? Jesus forgives you. Ask him to forgive you today.	<b>25</b> Read Matthew 27:27-31 How do you feel when you read these words? Why did Jesus die for us?	<b>26</b> Read Matthew 27:44-49 Download the YouVersion Bible App for Kids. Watch "In The Garden."	<b>27</b> Come to Serve Saturday @ 10am. Read Romans 5:8. Print the verse on paper and hang in your room. Thank Jesus for dying for you.	<b>28</b> <b>The Crucifixion</b>
