Goliath is trying to separate the Israelites from their home. What separates us from God?	3 1 Samuel 17:9-17 Make a list of what you know about David and what you know about Goliath. Which one LOOKS like they will be defeated in a fight? Why?	4 1 Samuel 17:18-26 David knows that God is the L_V_N_God is on their side. Add that to the list from yesterday! How does this change the outcome of the fight? Why?	5 1 Samuel 17:27-37 How had God prepared David for this battle? What are the rest of the Israelites doing? How many are prepared to defeat the enemy that wants to destroy the Israelites?	6 1 Samuel 17:38-50 and John 14:6 Who is the only one that can save you? Make a list of ways you can care for your family.	14 2 Kings 4: 6-7 Now the family can see how each step of obeying God has brought everything together. 16 Daniel 3 1-5 The statue was 90 feet tall and the King ask everyone to worship it. What was the King's heart focused on? Himself or the one true God? Why do you think that?	17 Daniel 3: 6-15 What did the King want the 3 men to do? Knowing what the punishment is, what would you do and why? Talk about it with a parent or friend and ask them!	18 Daniel 3: 16-20 What did the 3 men decide to do? No matter what was going to happen the men trusted God. If you were a King how would you instruct the people you were in charge of? Think about your friendships. How do you care for your friends and show them who Jesus is?	19 Daniel 3: 21-26 The 3 had been protected!! Draw a picture of the 3 men after they came out of the furnace! How would you have celebrated God? Have a God is Amazing party with your family!	20 Daniel 3: 27-30 How did the Kings heart and attitude change? Would that have happened if the 3 men would have obeyed the King? Who can see your obedience? Siblings, friends? 23 Daniel 5: 1-5 Where did the King get the golden cups? But who did he praise? A king leads other people. How is this king leading the people? Who is the King following? God or himself? Who are you following?	24 Daniel 5: 6-15 Draw a picture of what you think the handwriting on the wall looked like! What is the Queen's suggestion to figure out the case of the mysterious handwriting on the wall? Why did they call on Daniel?	25 Daniel 5:16-23 Daniel has not even started the interpretation but is revealing to the King what his attitude and actions say about him? Is Daniel being truthful? What do your actions reveal about you?	26 Daniel 5:24-28 What was Daniel's interpretation of the writing on the wall? How had the king used his time as a ruler? What would you do differently? Play King of the Kingdom with your family and let everyone rule the house for 3 minutes!	27 Daniel 5: 29 Did Belshazzar keep his word to Daniel? Do you think these things were important to Daniel?
