Take your Bible to church each Sun.</p>	<p>4</p> <p>Read Luke 4:16-17</p> <p>Find the book of Isaiah in your Bible. How many chapters are in Isaiah? Read Isaiah 61:6. What 4 things did Isaiah say Jesus would do to prove he is the son of God? Thank God for Jesus.</p>	<p>5</p> <p>Read Luke 4:16-18</p> <p>What scroll was given to Jesus to read? Read Isaiah 61:6. Isn't it amazing that Jesus read the same words when he was a boy? Read your Bible every day. Ask God to help you understand what you read.</p>	<p>6</p> <p>Read Luke 4:16-20</p> <p>What did the people do while Jesus read? Practice listening to your church teachers tomorrow. Draw a pic or write a thank you note for your teachers.</p>	<p>7</p> <p>Read Luke 4:16-21</p> <p>What did Jesus say about the scripture? Jesus said I am the one Isaiah was talking about. Make a scroll from paper tubes and paper. Write Jesus is God's son on your scroll.</p>	<p>8</p> <p>Jesus Taught in the Synagogue</p>
<p>9</p> <p>Read John 6:38</p> <p>Dip your finger in water and write the verse with water on a sidewalk. Read Romans 12:2. Reading the Bible each day can renew your mind!</p>	<p>10</p> <p>Read John 6:1-3</p> <p>Where was Jesus going? Who followed him? Why did they follow him? Who did he sit with? Who will you sit with today? Invite them to read this weeks DBR with you!</p>	<p>11</p> <p>Read John 6:4-6</p> <p>The Passover was a special meal to remember how God had rescued Israelites out of Egypt. Make a time capsule of things you want to remember God did in your family in 2022. Mark your calendar to open it in December! Write Jesus is God's Son to place inside.</p>	<p>12</p> <p>Read John 6:7-9</p> <p>Can man feed 5,000 on his own or is this something only God can do? Make a snack for your family. What would it be like to feed 5,000?</p>	<p>13</p> <p>John 6:10-11</p> <p>What did Jesus have the people do? What did Jesus do after he took the loaves of bread? Make a list of things you are thankful for! How much food did the people get? Who provided the food?</p>	<p>14</p> <p>John 6:12-13</p> <p>Did they waste or throw away the leftovers? Who can you invite to church tomorrow? Invite them today!</p>	<p>15</p> <p>Jesus Fed the People</p>
<p>16</p> <p>Matthew 14:22-23</p> <p>Jesus often went away by himself to pray. Pray by yourself today once in the morning in the evening</p>	<p>17</p> <p>Matthew 14:24-25</p> <p>Jesus walked on the water! That's incredible! Fill up a bucket with water and try to stand on it. Only Jesus can make that happen!</p>	<p>18</p> <p>Matthew 14:26-27</p> <p>When the disciples were afraid, Jesus helped make them calm. Draw a picture of Jesus walking on the water to remember he is always in control</p>	<p>19</p> <p>Matthew 14:28-29</p> <p>Peter also walked on water. Not because of his own power, but because he trusted in the Lord's power. Write three things on your mirror in expo marker that you can trust God in</p>	<p>20</p> <p>Matthew 14:30-31</p> <p>God is always there for us when we feel like we're sinking. How can you ask God to help you? Pray with your family at night before you go to bed</p>	<p>21</p> <p>Matthew 14:32-32</p> <p>The disciples say that Jesus is the Son of God! Make a note to give a friend that says "Jesus is the Son of God. Come to church with me on Sunday"</p>	<p>22</p> <p>Jesus Walked on Water</p>
<p>23</p> <p>Luke 17:11</p> <p>Look up how far Samaria & Galilee are. Count and walk that many steps.</p>	<p>24</p> <p>Luke 17:12-13</p> <p>Why did the lepers want Jesus to help them? Think about how you would feel in this situation.</p>	<p>25</p> <p>Luke 17:14</p> <p>This was a miracle! Jesus took care of them, and He takes care of us too. Pray a prayer of thanks to God.</p>	<p>26</p> <p>Luke 17:15-16</p> <p>How many lepers thanked Jesus? Write a thank you note to someone today.</p>	<p>27</p> <p>Luke 17:17-18</p> <p>Nine of the lepers did not thank Jesus and give Him praise. Sing your favorite praise song and thank God for blessing you.</p>	<p>28</p> <p>Luke 17:19</p> <p>What did Jesus say made the lepers well?
